Big Siblings Night

We would like to provide, on every second Wednesday of each month, a great discount opportunity for Big Brothers or Big Sisters to bring their little siblings to LFG Games for an evening of fun and play. LFG Games would provide to every Big Brother/Big Sister a free three-hour pass to play at our gaming centre from 7pm to 10pm. LFG Games is willing to provide 50% sponsorship of this 3 hour pass (\$15 value) for each Big Brother/Sister and their little sibling. We invite APBOT member organizations to provide additional sponsorship for the remaining \$15 value of the pass for each participating Big Brother/Sister and little sibling pair. Sponsorship amounts might constitute \$5, \$10 or \$15 of each pass, in any quantity the APBOT member is willing to provide. Together, I think we members of the APBOT can facilitate a great opportunity to enhance the already wonderful opportunity that becoming a Big Brother/Big Sister provides for a needful youth.

Single Parent Fun Night

In a similar vein to the Big Siblings Night outlined above, LFG Games would like to provide an opportunity for single parents who are members of Parents Without Partners (Oshawa or Toronto Chapters), who already struggle to provide entertainment for their children, to spend some quality time playing with their kids. On every third Tuesday of each month, LFG Games would provide a ½ price Single Parent Fun Night. LFG Games is willing to fund 30% of this discount (\$1.50 / hour/person) for four hours of play from 7pm to 11pm for any single parent and their children who visit our gaming centre. We invite APBOT member organizations to provide additional sponsorship for the remaining 20% of this discount (\$1.00/hour/person) for each participating Single Parent family. Raising children alone is already a hard enough job; together we can make it a little bit easier.

Ajax-Pickering Scout Fun Tournament

LFG Games would like to organize a round robin tournament between Ajax-Pickering Scout Troops. This tournament would take place over 4-12 weeks starting in September or October of this year. Each troop would field 1 or more 5 member teams to represent it and would participate against other teams from Ajax-Pickering troops. Final roster and ladder details will be developed as we understand the level of interest. LFG Games invites APBOT member organizations to provide sponsorship in the form of prizes, money for prizes or gifts of their products and/or services.
